Resolution Receiving Feasibility Report and Calling Hearing on Improvement

WHEREAS, pursuant to resolution of the council adopted March 5, 2020, a report has been prepared by Township Engineer Todd McLouth, P.E. of Loucks, 7200 Hemlock Lane, Suite 300, Maple Grove, MN 55369 with reference to the improvement of portions of 33rd Street and 82nd Avenue Road abutting City property within Sections 5 and 21, Princeton Township, Mille Lacs County, Minnesota by performing the following general work: The existing gravel roads shall be widened and improved to a bituminous top width of 22 feet with a one foot gravel shoulder. Aggregate gravel base shall be installed followed by bituminous paving and shouldering. The Feasibility Report was received by the council on March 26, 2020, and

WHEREAS, the report provides information regarding whether the proposed improvement is necessary, cost-effective, and feasible; whether it should best be made as proposed or in connection with some other improvement; the estimated cost of the improvement as recommended; and a description of the methodology used to calculate individual assessments for affected parcels.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF PRINCETON, MINNESOTA:

- 1. The council will consider the improvement of such street in accordance with the report and the assessment of abutting property¹ for all or a portion of the cost of the improvement pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 429 at an estimated total cost of the improvement of \$87,467.26.
- 2. A public hearing shall be held on such proposed improvement on the 26th day of March, 2020, in the council chambers of the city hall at 7:00 p.m. and the clerk shall give mailed and published notice of such hearing and improvement as required by law.
