Concrete flatwork of two ea, 5" thick x 5' wide sidewalks
Preparation, graveling and paving of 1300' of bituminous trail 8' wide
Grading, surface reinforcement, docks and concrete walk for boat launch & river access
Trail construction in MnDOT right of way both sides of the TH #95 bridge
Clearing and graveling of 4400' of 10' wide trail through wooded areas
Fire rings, campsites and picnic sites at remote locations
Associated culverts and drainage structures, pavement painting, and turf establishment
