

Rally Networks EACAM and RUS ReConnect Program Projects – Wasco County, Oregon



Project Update

Rally Networks (RN) has been granted funding from the FCC Enhanced EA-CAM USF and the USDA RUS Reconnect Program to build a high-speed 100% fiber broadband internet network to portions of Wasco County. RN is providing additional funding to ensure the completion of the projects. Fiber broadband technology offers the fastest speeds, lowest latency, and largest bandwidth available on the market. The above image shows the boundaries of the projects. The area within the EA-CAM boundary already has fiber access for portions of the project area. The areas that do not currently have fiber within the EA-CAM project boundary are in the Permitting and Environmental phase. Permit processing and environmental review timeframes are not yet known but can take a few months to a few years. The FCC requires the project to be completed by 2028.

The RUS Reconnect project is in permitting and environmental review. Permit processing and environmental review timeframes are not yet known but can take a few months to a few years.

Once permits are issued RN can finalize material procurement and begin construction. It is anticipated the projects will be completed by the end of 2028 but could be completed sooner depending on federal permitting and environmental processing.

Project Summary

Rally Networks (RN) is an Internet Service Provider (ISP) building two High-Speed Fiber Internet to the home projects using FCC Enhanced E-ACAM USF, USDA RUS Reconnect, and RN funding. RN is pleased to bring these projects to Wasco County Oregon. RN offers high-speed 100% fiber Internet to residential, commercial, educational, government, and community anchor institutions in some of the most remote and rural locations in Oregon. RN offers high-speed broadband 100% fiber internet service in rural locations rivaling that of Urban locations.

These projects will bring high-speed 100% fiber broadband to every broadband serviceable location within the build area including residents, businesses, governments, community anchor institutions, and farms. Residential customers within the area will have access to services with symmetrical speeds up to 2 GIGs as well as a host of Managed Wifi services including cybersecurity options. Business, institutional, and government customers can order managed services as needed. We are pleased to inform you of this important information so you have a resource to contact when you have citizens who want to know when they will receive access to high-speed internet.


What is Rally Networks?




