- SP 3-70c, Conflicts of Interest – Financial Transactions (*Adopted, separated “Conflicts” topics into individual SPs*)
- SP 4-60a, Acceptable Identification Process for Student Services Transactions (*Revised; Renumbered from SP 4-60*)
- SP 6-30a, Electronic Communications and Records Management and Retention; (*Revised; Retitled; Renumbered from SP 3-125d*)
- SP 8-70a, Unfair Competition (*Revised; Renumbered from SP 8-70*)
- SP 8-170, Contractual Indemnification Approval Process (*Repealed, statute prohibits*)
- SP 19-40b, Emergency Operations and Management Planning (*Revised*)
