From the Office of the CEO

FSMB Chair Katie Templeton, JD, FSMB Chair-elect George Abraham, MD, and I were in Washington, D.C., yesterday for a meeting of the **Coalition for Physician Accountability**, which meets twice a year and includes the senior leaders of the national organizations involved with the assessment, accreditation, licensure and certification of physicians. The meeting also included three public members of the group, including Pat Hunter (a previous member of the Vermont Board of Medical Practice) and John "Jake" Manahan, JD, of the Minnesota Board of Medical Practice, and was staffed by Andrea Ciccone, JD, FSMB's VP of Engagement and Member Services.

Areas of discussion included an update on the work of the Advisory Commission on Additional Licensing Models, which is welcoming comments and feedback until December 6, 2024, related to the first phase of its 10 recommendations for state medical boards considering an expedited pathway to licensure for international medical graduates who have already completed their post-graduate medical education in another country. We also discussed how several healthcare leaders are beginning to utilize privacy-enhanced software and tools based on generative artificial intelligence, including large language models, to ease their administrative tasks and duties. A government relations panel discussed some of the changes announced thus far by the incoming administration for federal agencies and healthcare delivery.
