

Since its launch in 2021, tens of thousands of physicians, PAs and nurses have registered with <u>Provider Bridge</u> -- a free technology platform that maintains a registry of health professionals that can be quickly accessed to respond to emergencies and public health crises.

In the wake of Hurricane Helene, and in preparing for Hurricane Milton, many hospitals and healthcare systems are facing staffing challenges as they work to provide care to their communities. Provider Bridge can be a vital resource during disasters by allowing licensed medical professionals to create, in a few minutes, a digital licensure "passport" that allows entities, including state medical boards, to rapidly search for verified medical professionals who are willing to deploy to a disaster site or provide in-person or telehealth services.
