

RESOLUTION 89-04

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING
OFFICIAL SIGNATURES FOR CHECKS

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WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 320; adopted by the Princeton City Council on December 10, 1981, re-established the office of Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes Chapter 412.271 requires the signature of Mayor, Clerk and Treasurer on all checks issued by the City; and

WHEREAS, facsimile signatures are allowed by Minnesota Statutes 47.41 and seem desirable as a convenience; and

WHEREAS, it seems advisable for the duly appointed acting Mayor to sign in the absence of the Mayor.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Princeton, Minnesota:

1. The elected or duly appointed personnel occupying the offices of Mayor, Acting Mayor, Clerk, Deputy Clerk and Treasurer are authorized to sign checks for the City and are directed to sign the "Authorized Signature" cards required by approved depositories.
2. All checks must have the signatures of the Mayor or in the Mayor's absence the Acting Mayor, the Clerk or Deputy Clerk and the Treasurer. Only one of these may be a facsimile signature used upon the officer's express authorization.
