Mayor and Council,

The Emergency Management team budgeted for an Informational/Speed trailer in C.I.P. this year. We have tried to get different quotes from different suppliers for these trailers. The problem is that not all the suppliers provide the same services. We have found a trailer that will perform well for our city needs.

This trailer can be utilized by different departments making it beneficial for the city to own. Fire will be able to use it during training events, active fire events and during R.E.P. training and drills. Police will be able to use it for speed control and data along with traffic direction. Public works will be able to use it during road work and usage. These are only a few of the ideas that each department would be able to utilize this trailer for.

We have \$28,000.00 in the C.I.P. for the purchase of the trailer. The cost of the trailer is \$15,980.00. The R.E.P. program is able to pay \$1000.00 towards the trailer as well. We are looking for permission to purchase this trailer along with graphics and ancillary equipment not to exceed \$21,000.00. We will be available for questions. Thank you.
