SUBJECT: Approval to enter into Emergency Department pediatric surgery concurrent call coverage at BHMC and BHCS above the 90th percentile and pediatric surgery non-concurrent call coverage at BHMC above the 90th percentile.

BACKGROUND

The district is requesting approval to enter into contractual agreements above the 90th percentile for pediatric surgery concurrent call coverage at BHMC and BHCS and pediatric surgery non-concurrent call coverage at BHMC. All regions have documented and objectively determined there is a legitimate business purpose for qualified physicians to provide pediatric surgery call coverage services.

ACTION/PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Broward Health is requesting that the Board of Commissioners of the North Broward Hospital District authorize the district to enter concurrent and non-concurrent call coverage contracts benchmarked above the 90th percentile. A valuation report was completed by an independent third-party appraisal company which determined that the proposed arrangements are commercially reasonable, and the compensation is within fair market value.

JUSTIFICATION

The district has documented and objectively determined that there is a legitimate business purpose to continue to provide compensation for pediatric surgery call coverage services at BHMC and BHCS. Hospitals are required under the Emergency Medical Treatment and Active Labor Act of 1986 (“EMTALA”) to provide evaluation of management of patients presenting to its Emergency Department. In accordance with EMTALA, BHMC and BHCS have a documented need to contract with the physicians and physician groups to provide unrestricted call coverage for patients presenting to the hospitals’ Emergency Departments. Because of physician shortages, it has become essential for concurrent coverage to be provided to fulfill the need for ongoing patient care in these areas.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Therefore, it is requested that the Board of Commissioners of the North Broward Hospital District authorize the District to enter into Emergency Department pediatric surgery concurrent call coverage at Broward Health Medical Center and Broward Health Coral Springs above the 90th percentile and pediatric surgery non-concurrent call coverage at Broward Health Medical Center above the 90th percentile.
