EXPLANATION:

As part of the Teaching Excellence Initiative, the SBCCOE invested in expanding the Active Learning Institute from FRCC for all CCCS college teams. Kerri Mitchell and Eric Salahub, longtime FRCC faculty and instructional coaches, developed and facilitated the Active Learning Institute for 6-years for small cohorts of teachers at FRCC. Since 2017, more than 200 of our FRCC colleagues have completed the Active Learning Institute. Since Fall 2022, more than 160 CCCS faculty have participated in Active Learning Institute cohorts. This presentation serves as an update about the investment and an invitation to see a training in action.
