RELATIONSHIP TO THE STRATEGIC PLAN:

Redefine our value proposition through accessibility, affordability, quality, accountability, resource development, and operational excellence.

EXPLANATION:

In April 2022, the Board approved FY 2022-23 fees for all colleges. However, Lamar Community College inadvertently listed their room and board fee for a Kitchenette Single Occupancy (no meals) room as \$1,700 per term rather than \$3,400 per term. As such, they are requesting to correct that fee to \$3,400 per term.

In addition, Pueblo Community College inadvertently included a \$10.00 malpractice fee on their Emergency Medical Services (EMS) 180 course and is requesting to remove it. They also inadvertently excluded an increase for their mandatory fees on Table 2 of the fee tables and are requesting to increase those by 2.0 percent (see Attachment A).

Also, Northeastern Junior College has corrections to a number of fees that can be found in Attachment A.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends the Board approve the fee adjustments described above and included in Attachment A.
