Summary of Key Observations/Recommendations

University Regulation UCF-4.029 governs the use of university facilities and grounds for events, including expressive activities, demonstrations, and protests. The regulation is amended to:

- add new language to section (5)(c), which articulates conditions for persons or groups when using university facilities and grounds. Specifically, language is added to prohibit persons from: restricting the movement of others; wearing items to conceal identity under certain circumstances; and refusing to provide identification when requested by a university official or law enforcement official in the course of their duties.
- specifying outdoor use spaces on the downtown campus (section (7)),
- adding additional clarification related to signage and displays in connection with events (section (5)(a)), and
- making small corrections elsewhere in the regulation.

Additional Background

This regulation was last amended on June 25, 2024.

Implementation Plan

The amended regulation will take effect upon approval by the UCF Board of Trustees.

Resource Considerations

The proposed regulation amendments are not anticipated to incur additional costs to the University.
