1.Describe the purpose of the grant.

The grant is intended to support people, services, and organizations to create a cradle-to-career pipeline, through which members of disadvantaged communities have access to high-quality early care and education, smooth and effective transition to kindergarten, excellent K-12 schools, and pathways to achieve postsecondary and career success. This subaward agreement is for expenses related to the grant that the College incurred prior to October 1, the date the grant transferred to FAU. The College was unable to be directly reimbursed by the US Department of Education for expenses incurred prior to October 1 in the amount of \$739,711.07. This subaward agreement will allow FAU to reimburse the College for these expenses.

2.Describe the College's plans for meeting the grant requirements. Include details such as staffing plan and how any match requirements will be met.

Grant funds will reimburse for Promise Neighborhoods grant expenses already incurred, between May 2024 and September 2024. These include expenses incurred by subrecipients, as well as Broward College.
