

R506, Guidance on Categorizing Budget Related and Self Supporting Courses¹

R506-1 Purpose: To provide a policy for categorizing courses as budget-related or self-supporting for state funding purposes and for cost studies.

R506-3 Policy: The Office of the Commissioner of Higher Education ("OCHE") will develop guidance for institutions of higher education for categorizing budget-related and self-supporting courses ("Guidance"). The Guidance shall detail the data institutions shall provide to OCHE for such courses, how to define the data elements, and how to properly format the data.

- **3.1 Supervised Instruction**: For a course to be included in the USHE Course Inventory, the course must include instruction, and the institution must supervise the instruction.
- **3.2 Separate Designation for Credit and Not for Credit Courses**: Whenever a specific course offering can be taken either for credit or not for credit, the different registration categories must be provided by separate section numbers scheduled at the same time and location.
