**RE:** Emergency Ordinance 23-90 - An Emergency Ordinance of the Council of the City of Saint

Paul Regarding Mitigation/Protective Measures to Prevent the Spread of COVID-19

Throughout Saint Paul Island

**SUMMARY:** Emergency Ordinance 23-90 extends the City of Saint Paul COVID-19 mitigation/protective measures for an additional 30 days.

**PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION:** Council extended this emergency ordinance for an additional 30 days on February 16, 2023.

**BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION:** On March 26, 2020, the City Council approved a resolution declaring COVID-19 a local emergency and established a travel ban. In April of 2020 City Council approved the first emergency ordinance regarding mitigation/protective measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19 throughout Saint Paul Island. Over the past three years there have been numerous versions of this emergency ordinance. Community COVID-19 mitigation measures have included:

- Pre-travel testing
- Post travel testing
- Post travel quarantine ranging from 5 days to 14 days
- Resident and essential worker travel only
- Social distancing
- Use of anĝiliisix (breath catchers/face masks/face coverings)
- Community/Workforce Protection Plans

The current proposed emergency ordinance requires travelers to submit a pre and post travel COVID-19 test.

The Biden administrative has announced plant to end the COVID-19 public health emergency and national emergency on May 11, 2023.

**ALTERNATIVES:** Council could choose not to extend this emergency ordinance.

**FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:** The cost to implement this emergency ordinance is minimal at this point in time.

**LEGAL:** No significant changes have occurred to this emergency ordinance for several months; therefore the City's general legal counsel has not reviewed Emergency Ordinance 23-90.

## ADMINISTRATION COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATION: None.

**PROPOSED MOTION:** I move to approve Emergency Ordinance 23-90.
