#### **Progress**

- The system has treated 11,670 admitted COVID-19 patients with a 92% discharge rate.
- The system has administered 672 monoclonal treatments as of Sept. 20.
- Debora Duro, M.D., BHPG, presented lectures on the benefits of plant-based diets in children at national conference and on gastroesophageal reflux at FL chapter of American Academy of Pediatrics.
- Dr. Duro and BHMC intestinal rehab program had 5th paper accepted for publication in less than 1 year.

#### **Progress**

- BHMC volumes growth over FY21: transplant 25%, robotics 42% and biplane 55.4%.
- BHIP projected to reach required 50 cases for Bariatric Center of Excellence by end of November.
- BHIP's cardiac catheterization lab and BHCS's second cath lab are underway.
- Over 200 surgeries are scheduled from Broward Health Physician Group.
- The children's hospital pediatric transfers increased by 38% in July and 22% in August.

#### **Broward Health Coral Springs:**

- Completed 70 cardiac cases completed in August (43 diagnostic and 27 PCI cases).
- Performed 58 robotic cases in August, the second highest volume since 2018.
- OB Laborist program is scheduled to open in February 2022.
