John – Tried to give you a call but I have a few comments/questions regarding this schedule:

- Item 48, Building B Bi Fold Door Install is currently tied to the completion of electrical installation for Building B which is forcing it to start on 9/5. Should this not be tied to Item 42, the Bi Fold Door Install for Building A? I believe this link is artificially pushing the rest of the schedule back.
- Is there any need to wait for the breaker panel to be delivered before completing the remaining paving/marking/sodding? Once the doors are installed, I don't see any need to delay these items.
- I understand the current situation with breaker panel delay and that construction sequencing means that other construction items are inevitably impacted by this delay. With that, my expectations are that every item not directly dependent on this breaker panel be completed prior to the current contract end date of 8/24.
