



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Recommendation that the Broward College District Board of Trustees authorize the standard agreement (purchase order) with the Florida Association of Collegiate Registrars & Admissions Officers (FACRAO) for membership renewal dues for FY 2024-2025 for the Registrar's Office. Fiscal Impact: \$250.00.

What is the purpose of this contract and why is it needed? The Florida Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers (FACRAO) has provided Florida's enrollment professionals with a forum to address issues affecting Broward College and its profession. Membership in FACRAO helps the College's officers increase their expertise, whether they work in admissions, registration, records, data management, international education, or financial aid. This agreement is for the period July 2024 - June 2025.

What procurement process or bid waiver was used and why?

Small purchase for Category One (\$0.00 - \$10,000) per College Procedure A6Hx2-6.34 was used, where there are no formal or informal competitive requirements for goods and services acquired by the College at this dollar threshold. Membership dues, per the Florida Statute 119.01(3) requires that all financial, business and membership records held by the organization in relation to the individual(s) or organization(s) for whom a purchase order is being issued are to be considered public records and shall be subject to the provisions of Florida Statute 119.07.

Is this a budgeted expenditure from the budget established at the last June Board of Trustees meeting?

Yes, it was a budgeted expense that was approved at the June 2023 Board meeting.

What fund, cost center and line item(s) were used? Fund - FD100 Cost Center - CC0483 Line Item - 40700.

Has Broward College used this vendor before for these products or services? Yes, Broward College has used the services of the Florida Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers to offer this membership for more than nineteen (19) years to date.

Was the product or service acceptable in the past? Yes, the membership was advantageous in the past. It has allowed Broward College to remain current in providing services to its students and former students in keeping with the norms of the industry (it can be bench-marked against other institution) and utilizing the technology available in the industry.

Was there a return on investment anticipated when entering this contract? Yes.

Was that return on investment not met, met, or exceeded and how? The return on investment was met, because it has allowed Broward College to garner industry specific information and knowledge that can be used to improve its service delivery.

Does this directly or indirectly feed one of the Social Enterprise tactics and how? The services provided feeds indirectly into the Social Enterprise tactics because it allows Broward College to bench mark its services against industry leaders and to use this to improve its services to the community.

Did the vendor amend Broward College's legal terms and conditions [to be answered by the Legal Office] if the College's standard contract was used and was this acceptable to the Legal Office?


