Recommendation that the Broward College District Board of Trustees authorize a standard agreement (purchase order) with David White to provide piano tuning and instrument maintenance services for the Fall 2024 and Spring 2025 semesters. Fiscal Impact: \$7,730.00.

What is the purpose of this contract and why is it needed?

This purpose of this contract with David White Piano Tuning Services is to provide necessary and routine annual tuning and maintenance to the fleet of thirty-two non-Steinway pianos located on Central Campus. Tuning is required of all instruments prior to the start of each major academic term for student practice, recital and performance.

What procurement process or bid waiver was used and why?

Small purchase for Category One (\$0.00 - \$10,000) per College Procedure A6Hx2-6.34 was used, where there are no formal or informal requirements for goods and services acquired by the College at this dollar threshold. One quote was obtained by the requesting department to identify the best value for the required commodity or service.

Is this a budgeted expenditure from the budget established at the last June Board of Trustees meeting?

This item makes use of the annual budget established during the July Board of Trustees meeting.

What fund, cost center and line item(s) were used? CC0530, FD101 Fund 101 CUF, GLC 62500 and CC0531, FD101 Fund 101, GLC 62500.

Has Broward College used this vendor before for these products or services? Yes.

Was the product or service acceptable in the past? Yes.

Was there a return on investment anticipated when entering this contract?

Yes, the return on investment anticipated will be the upkeep and maintenance of our thirty-two non-Steinway fleet of pianos for student and faculty use.

It will be met upon the execution of services outlined in the standard service agreement.
