WHEREAS, there is a need and desire for the City of Saint Paul, Aleut Community of Saint Paul Island, Tanadqusix Corporation and Central Bering Sea Fishermen's Association to work together for the overall better of the community of Saint Paul Island; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Saint Paul, Aleut Community of Saint Paul Island, Tanadqusix Corporation and Central Bering Sea Fishermen's Association voluntarily agreed to mutually develop and implement community strategic and economic plans for the overall betterment of the community of Saint Paul Island; and,

WHEREAS, the Ataqan Akun serves as a common expression of the unifying concept for the community that, "We are One," in seeking a unified vision for the future development and betterment of the community of Saint Paul Island; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the City of Saint Paul by this resolution approves the Ataqan Akun Executive Planning Committee Memorandum of Understanding.
