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**WILLIAM & MARY  
APPROVAL OF THE UNIVERSITY CRISIS AND  
EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Visitors and the President are concerned with the health and well-being of its students, faculty and staff and desires that the best possible emergency services be available to them;

**WHEREAS**, the §23.1-804 of the *Code of Virginia* requires that any public institution of higher education shall develop, adopt, and keep current a written crisis and emergency management plan (CEMP);

**WHEREAS**, every four years, each institution is required to conduct a comprehensive review and revision of that plan to ensure it remains current and that such review must be certified in writing to the Virginia Department of Emergency Management;

**WHEREAS**, the revised plan must be adopted formally by the Board of Visitors or other governing body;

**WHEREAS**, William & Mary's plan was developed by the William & Mary Emergency Management Team in coordination with the Virginia Department of Emergency Management with input from various William & Mary departments and local municipal Emergency Management Agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, recent revisions to the plan include explicitly incorporating the Virginia Institute of Marine Science into the plan, adjusting staff roles and titles, and including an updated exercise schedule;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Visitors, does hereby officially adopt the university's updated Crisis and Emergency Management plan, to include plans and procedures for both natural and human-caused disasters.
