EXPLANATION:

Board Policy 9-20 requires each CCCS college to develop a Comprehensive Academic Plan (CAP) and to update that plan every academic year. Each CAP should describe the goals and the priorities of the college for the academic year in line with facility and technology planning goals. CAPs are to be submitted to the Vice Chancellor for Academic and Student Affairs in May of each year for approval.

This report includes the CAP for all 13 CCCS colleges, each of which has been approved by the Vice Chancellor for Academic and Student Affairs.
