RELATIONSHIP TO THE STRATEGIC PLAN:

Redefine our value proposition through accessibility, affordability, quality, accountability, resource development, and operational excellence.

EXPLANATION:

In April 2022, the Board approved FY 2022-23 fees for all colleges. However, Northeastern Junior College has subsequently requested removal of the Digital Content Fee from its Human Anatomy and Physiology I and Human Anatomy and Physiology II courses (BIO 201 and BIO 202), which was set at \$66.00 per course. In addition, the Community College of Aurora inadvertently omitted a program fee for their Basic Electrical course (ASE 102) and is requesting to include a fee of \$500 per course.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends the Board approve the fee removal and fee addition described above.
