## FY2025 Supplemental Budget Request

#### FY2024-FY2025 Biennial Budget New Funding versus Estimated New Cost Increases

#### **Further Development of Supplemental Request**

- Ongoing and additional consultation occurred with bargaining units, statewide student associations, Leadership Council, and others between first and second reading of supplement request.
- The need for additional resources was strongly endorsed. Feedback included the need to ask for more than \$61 million as well as asking for additional dedicated funding to support student needs.
- Allocation of the new resources would align with how the funding for this biennium was distributed to colleges and universities.
  - 62% allocated using the allocation model
  - 38% based on the methodology used to distribute funding to support the tuition freeze

### **Recommended Action**

The Finance and Facilities Committee recommends that the Board of Trustees approves the fiscal year 2025 request in the amount of \$61,000,000 in ongoing base funding. Full funding of the \$61,000,000 would provide colleges and universities additional resources to support ongoing biennial costs that currently exceed the additional ongoing biennial revenue.

The Board of Trustees has been granted the authority in state statute to govern and operate Minnesota State. The board, after full consultation with Minnesota State constituencies, will make final budget decisions at the conclusion of the legislative session.
