- SP 4-30a, Appendix A, Code of Student Behavioral Expectations and Responsibilities (Revised)
  - Minor revision, only to address SB24-131 new concealed carry laws
- SP 9-30a, Associate Degrees (Revised)
  - Minor revision to address legal updates
- SP 19-60a, Civil Rights and Sexual Misconduct Resolution Process (*Revised*)
- SP 19-60c, Digital Accessibility (Revised, Retitled, and Renumbered from SP 3-125g)
  - Moved to Safety, Security, and Civil Rights series from Personnel series
