Collegiate High School hosted a Showcase for new, incoming students on Thursday, April 20, from 5:30 p.m.-7 p.m. More than 400 parents and students attended. Parents and students were able to tour both Collegiate High School buildings, view activities occurring in each classroom, learn about clubs, and tour the ESports and Robotics Team rooms. It was an amazing turnout! We are looking forward to an incredible 2023-2024 school year with engaged, supportive students and parents. CHS also conducted orientation of new students and parents on May 2-3 and 9-10. Our team is excited for the new year ahead.

Eight students from Collegiate High School participated in the 2023 Okaloosa County Schools/Mattie Kelly Art Show. A 10th grade student, Kanyon Fort, won 2nd place for Digital Photography. An 11th grade student, Kayda Daigle, won a 3rd place ribbon for Pottery/Sculpture.

Two students who will be 9th graders at CHS during the upcoming school year, Adyla Muhlbach and Isabelle Rushing, will be singing the National Anthem at the both the CHS Awards Ceremony and the CHS Graduation this year. We are excited to feature CHS's talents and skills in performing arts.

A total of sixteen CHS students were published in this year's *Blackwater Review*, which was unveiled in April.
