RESOLUTION OF THE DILKON CHAPTER OF THE NAVAJO NATION

**SUPPORTING AND APPROVING TO LEASE AND UTILIZE THE BUILDING
FORMERLY LEASED TO THE NAVAJO NATION HEADSTART PROGRAM TO DINÉ
COLLEGE.**

WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C Section 3(A) the Dilkon Chapter is a duly recognized certified chapter of the Navajo Nation Government, as listed at 11N.N.C, part 1, Section 10; and
2. Pursuant to 26 N.N.C Section 1 (B) Dilkon Chapter is vested with the authority to review all matters affecting the community; and
3. Dilkon Chapter is vested with the authority to make appropriate decisions on behalf of the community and to make recommendations to the Navajo Nation and other agencies for appropriate actions; and
4. Diné College is a non-profit post-secondary educational institution chartered by the Navajo Nation Council in 1968 for the purposes of providing educational opportunities to the Navajo people and others in areas important to the economic and social development of the Navajo Nation and other purposes, 10 NNC § 2002; and
5. Diné College is committed to overall wellness of its students and surrounding community during this time, while ensuring protective measures are implemented to reduce the spread of COVID-19; and
6. Diné College is committed to develop distance learning capabilities and opportunities in many innovative ways. To expand reliable internet access needs and create a delivery environment strategy to produce high quality courses.
7. Diné College is strategically situating learning centers to provide internet access to Navajo students from k-12 to post-secondary students and provide a safe environment for learning during this pandemic.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT;

The Dilkon Chapter supports and approves to lease and utilize the building formerly leased to the Navajo Nation Headstart program (fenced in area) to Diné College.
