**Resolution No.: 04-19-22-01**

**COUNTY REDISTRICTING PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, Minnesota Statutes Chapter 375 establishes the procedure and process for redistricting County Commissioner districts based on population figures from the Federal Census; and

**WHEREAS**, Minnesota Statutes § 204B.135, Subd. 2 requires County Commissioner districts to be redistricted within 80 days of the legislative redistricted, or at least 15 weeks before the state primary election, whichever comes first; and

**WHEREAS**, Minnesota Statutes § 375.025, Subd. 4 states that there shall be a new election of commissioners in all the districts at the next general election except that if the change made in the boundaries of a district is less than five percent of the average of all districts of the county, the commissioner in office at the time of the redistricting shall serve for the full period for which elected.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mille Lacs County Board of Commissioners that the redistricting plan below is hereby adopted as required pursuant to the aforementioned Statutes.

- **District 1:** The City of Princeton
  - Continuation of existing term; 4-Year Term, 2024 Election
- **District 2:** The Townships of Princeton, Greenbush and Milo and the City of Pease.
  - 4-Year Term, 2022 Election
- **District 3:** The Township of Milaca and the Cities of Foreston and Milaca.
  - Continuation of existing term; 4-Year Term, 2024 Election
- **District 4:** The Townships of Bogus Brook, Borgholm, Hayland, Page, Mudgett, Dailey, Lewis, Onamia and the City of Bock.
  - 4-Year Term, 2022 Election
- **District 5:** The Townships of Bradbury, Isle Harbor, South Harbor, Kathio and East Side and the Cities of Isle, Wahkon and Onamia.
  - Continuation of existing term; 4-Year Term, 2024 Election



**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Mille Lacs County Auditor-Treasurer is hereby directed to file the redistricting plan with the Minnesota Secretary of State's Office by May 1, 2022 to be effective for the 2022 primary and general election, and to publish the redistricting plan as required in the official newspaper.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the districts are, for illustrative purposes, identified in a map of the Mille Lacs County attached hereto and marked as Exhibit A, which by reference is hereby made a part hereof.


