



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Recommendation that the Broward College District Board of Trustees authorize the standard agreement (blanket purchase order) with Homeyer Consulting Services, Inc. to perform Thermal Energy and Cooling Tower Water Biological Analyses per location on an on-needed basis during FY2024-2025. Fiscal Impact: Estimated \$9,995.00.

What is the purpose of this contract and why is it needed? The purpose of this contract is to perform Thermal Energy and Cooling Tower Water Biological Analyses College-wide to monitor the HVAC System water treatment program, and to identify costly problems before they can create serious mechanical breakdown conditions college-wide.

What procurement process or bid waiver was used and why? Small purchase for Category One (\$0.00 - \$10,000) per College Procedure A6Hx2-6.34 was used, where there is no formal or informal competitive requirements for goods and services acquired by the College at this dollar threshold. One quote was obtained per campus location to identify the best value for the required commodity or service. This is imperative to the operation of the College.

Is this a budgeted expenditure from the budget established at the last June Board of Trustees meeting? Yes, June 2024 approved budget.

What fund, cost center and line item(s) were used? FD100, CC0108.

Has Broward College used this vendor before for these products or services? Yes, Broward College has used this vendor before for these services.

Was the product or service acceptable in the past? Yes, the services were acceptable in the past.

Was there a return on investment anticipated when entering this contract? Yes, there was a return on investment is to provide in depth analysis of the HVAC water systems to determine contaminants that may be harmful to the environment.. The services used verified the safe operation of the Thermal Energy and Cooling Towers College wide.

Was that return on investment not met, met, or exceeded and how?The return has exceeded the investment over the life of the systems.

The system was implemented in the year 2000 with savings on utility costs to the college since that time.
