- The system has treated 8,100 admitted COVID-19 patients with a 92% discharge rate.
- U.S. News and World Report rated Broward Health hospitals in High Performer specialty categories:
  - BHMC: COPD, heart failure, hip replacement, heart attack, kidney failure and stroke
  - BHN: stroke and hip replacement
  - BHCS: COPD and kidney failure
- Monoclonal antibody treatment for COVID-19 enhanced to treat emerging variants.
- BHMC is the only hospital in Broward County to participate in two A-fib clinical trials.

- Onsite retail pharmacy at CDTC broke ground and expected to open in Fall.
- BHIP performed 21% more cath procedures and has increased cases every month this CY.
- BHIP increased da Vinci Xi cases by 35% and OP surgeries by 9.6% (35 cases) over prior month.
