The contract with Warehouse 21 has been canceled due to concerns about their capacity to complete the Talent Transition Project and an identified billing discrepancy in their invoice. As a result, work is underway for a bid exception request to obtain another contractor who already works with another state entity and has demonstrated excellent outreach and marketing through their current projects.
