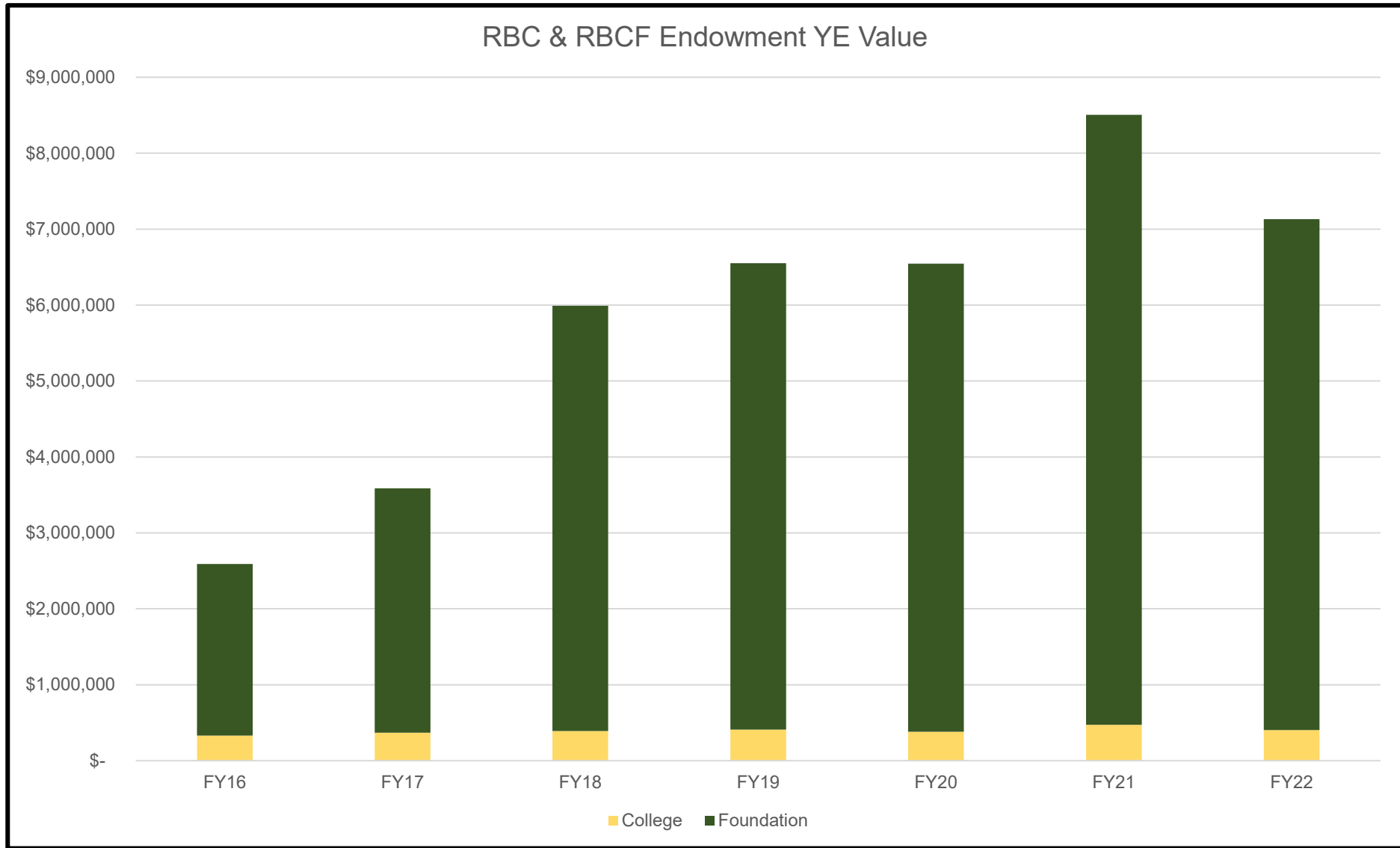
Richard Bland College Foundation Announces \$296,000 in Scholarships Awarded This Fall

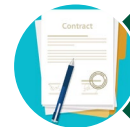
