ORDINANCE 16-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL, ALASKA, REVISING THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES SECTION 7.5, SALES TAX, REPEALING THE SMALL VESSEL EXEMPTION AND INCREASING THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL:

Section 1. Classification. Section 2 of this ordinance shall become a permanent part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Saint Paul.

Section 2. Amendment.

Section 7.5, Exemptions from Sales Tax, of the City Code of Ordinances, subsection (I) shall be repealed:

7.5 (I) Sales of fish caught on vessels forty-six feet or less length over all (LOA). Section 7.6 Certificate of Registration and Estimated Production shall be amended to read as follows, in bold print:

7.6 (a) The application shall be on a form prescribed by the City, shall be filed not later than January 15th of each year, **or prior to the start of business if after January,** and shall be accompanied by a thirty-five forty dollar (\$35.00 **40.00**) fee.

Section 3. Severability. As provided in the City Code of Ordinances Chapter 1, Section 1.7, Severability, if any portion of this ordinance is subsequently found to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other parts of this ordinance.

Section 4. Duration. This ordinance shall remain in effect until revised by the City Council in accordance with the procedures set forth in Chapter 1, Section 1.8, Amendments to the Code.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective thirty days following its adoption by the City Council.
