# **THE WORKFORCE SYSTEM SERVES Businesses, Employers, Workforce Residents and Job Seekers**

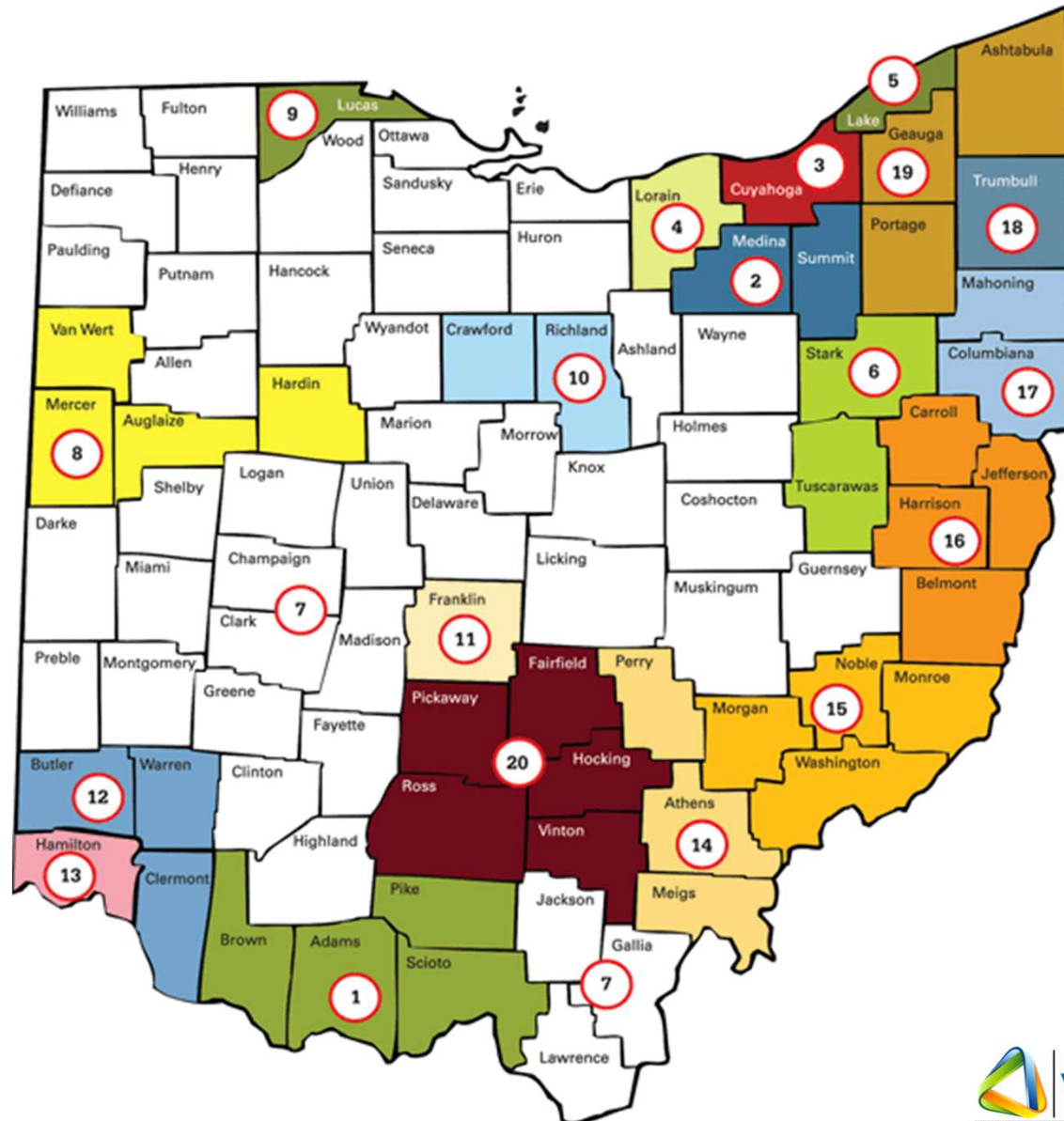
The workforce system provides employment, education and training services to successfully connect the employers and job seekers of the area.

- **WIOA:** Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act passed by Congress July 22, 2014 (generates some of the laws we follow)

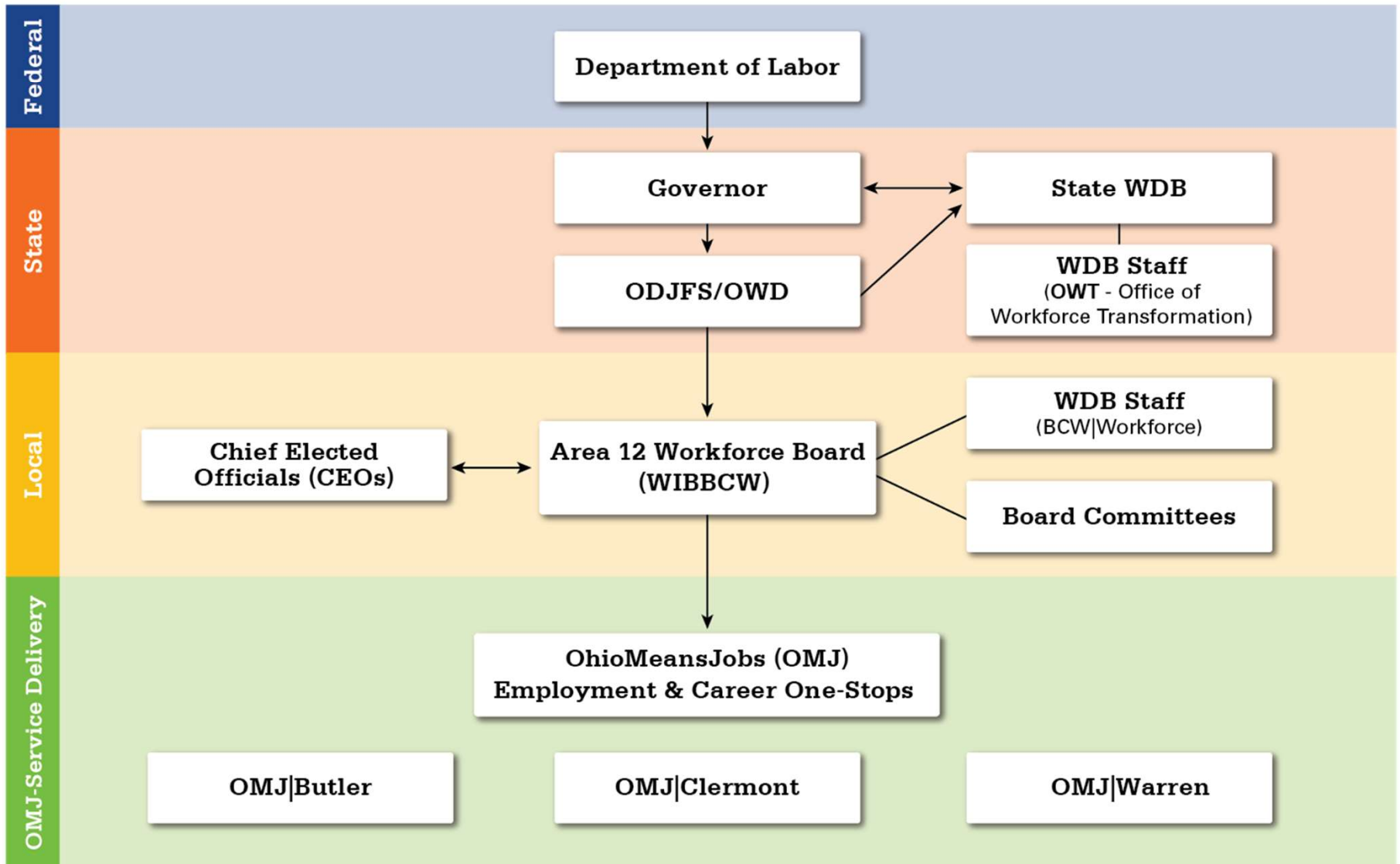

# BOARD DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

The **WIBBCW** provides strategic and operational oversight of the local area to help the State achieve its vision and goals, satisfy customers and continuously improve the quality and effectiveness of services.

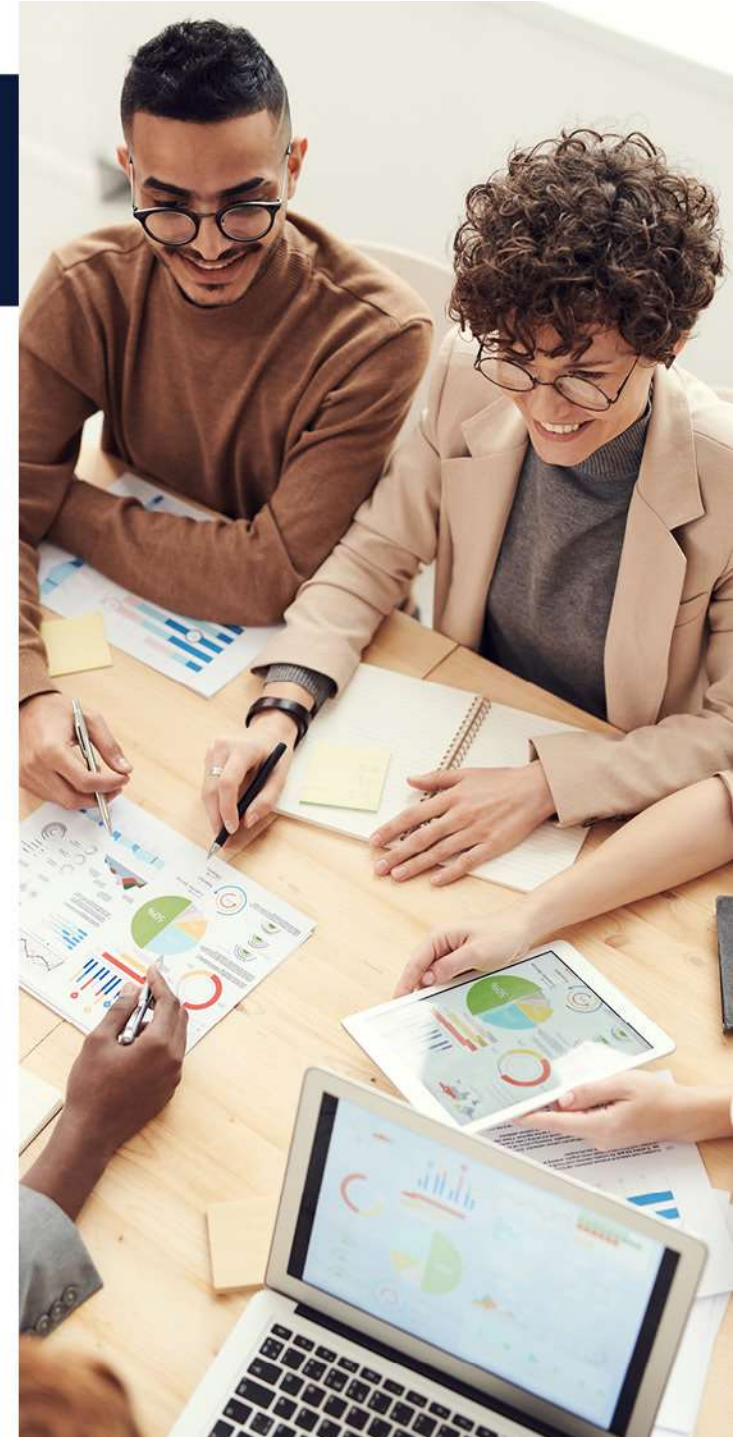
## Duties and Responsibilities Include:

- Develop and submit a local & regional plans;
- Conduct workforce research and regional labor market analysis;
- Convene local workforce development system stakeholders for assistance and support;



# BOARD DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Engage a diverse range of employers and other entities in the region;
- Lead efforts to develop and implement career pathways;
- Lead efforts to identify and promote proven and promising strategies and initiatives to meet the needs of employers, workers, and job seekers;
- Conduct oversight of adult, dislocated worker, and youth programs and the entire workforce delivery system, ensure the appropriate use and management of WIOA funds, and ensure the appropriate use, management, and investment of funds to maximize performance outcomes;





# BOARD DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Identify local performance measures with the CEO and the State;
- Negotiate with the CEO and required partners for the OMJ System's Memorandum of Understanding;
- Select providers for the OMJ One-Stop System Operator, OMJ Career Services and Emerging Workforce (Youth) Services;
- Develop a budget for Board activities;
- Certify the area's OhioMeansJobs One-Stops.
