Thirteen Virginia cadets traveled to Richmond to meet with their district legislators during the 2024 General Assembly Session. This annual visit by cadets is a highlight of the Session.

The cadets met with their legislators in the morning and were introduced in the House of Delegates and Senate at noon. Senator Jennifer Carroll Foy '03 introduced the cadets in the Senate and Delegate Terry Austin in the House.

It is an opportunity for cadets to learn about the legislative process and ask questions about the issues in play. It is also a chance for legislators to learn from cadets about why they chose VMI and its unique educational environment.
