PERC EDUCATION PROGRAM: WHAT HAS CHANGED?

Within the propane industry there has long been a demand for more modular training. PEP will benefit employees in multiple ways.



New propane industry employees will be learning what they need to know, when they need to know it.



Course completion rates are higher, due to the smaller scale of each module and learning path.



PEP is broken into shorter, task-specific modules which are designed to increase learner retention.



PEP can be customized to fit employee and company needs; more programs and electives are available to learners.



Employees can get to work faster and hit the ground running because they only need to complete training specific to their job function.

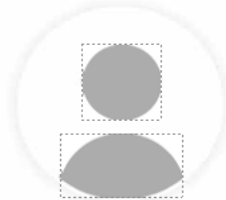
