**SOLAR ENERGY SYSTEMS
MORATORIUM EXTENSION**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution #9-21-25, effective September 16, 2021, Lee County established the Renewable Energy Committee to review the ordinances, resolutions, and policies related to solar energy system development in Lee County; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution #12-21-011, dated December 21, 2021, the Lee County Board placed a moratorium on accepting zoning petitions for new non-residential solar energy systems, until June 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution # 05-22-009, dated May 19, 2022, the Lee County Board placed a moratorium on accepting zoning petitions for new non-residential solar energy systems greater than five (5) megawatts, until September 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Renewable Energy Committee is seeking an extension of the solar energy system moratorium for non-residential solar energy projects which are greater than five (5) megawatts, to complete the review of the policies and ordinances pertaining to solar energy systems.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that effective upon passage by the Lee County Board, the moratorium on accepting zoning petitions for new non-residential solar energy systems greater than five (5) megawatts is hereby in place until October 31, 2022.
