RELATIONSHIP TO THE STRATEGIC PLAN: Transform the Student Experience; Transform our own Workforce Experience

EXPLANATION: As part of the effort by Legal Affairs to review and update all policies and procedures over a five year period of time, Academic and Student Affairs reviewed BP 4-25. In partnership with the State Student Advisory Council, this policy was updated to include that the Student Board Member serves a one-year term on the State Board. In addition, the policy was revised to include that the SSAC representative from a college campus must be enrolled in a minimum of 9 credit hours and that their term begins July 1 and ends June 30. All other changes were non-substantive and/or editorial.

The attached BP 4-25 reflects the non-substantive, editorial, or conforming changes to the policy. A redline version showing the details of all revisions is available upon request.

RECOMMENDATION: CCCS Staff recommends the Board approve the revisions to Board Policy BP 3-65.
