RELATIONSHIP TO THE STRATEGIC PLAN: Transform the Student Experience;
Transform our own Workforce Experience

EXPLANATION: As part of the effort by Legal Affairs to review and update all policies and procedures over a five year period of time, Academic and Student Affairs reviewed BP 9-20. The revised policy stipulates that each college shall develop a comprehensive academic plan and update it annually. Furthermore, those plans should align with facility and technology planning goals. Lastly, the policy requires these plans be approved each year by the Chancellor and his or her designee(s).

The attached BP 9-20 reflects the non-substantive, editorial, or conforming changes to the policy. A redline version showing the details of all revisions is available upon request.

RECOMMENDATION: CCCS Staff recommends the Board approve the revisions to Board Policy 9-20. Furthermore, CCCS Staff recommends the Board delegate authority to approve comprehensive academic plans to the Chancellor and his or her designee(s).
