RELATIONSHIP TO THE STRATEGIC PLAN: Transform the Student Experience;
Transform our own Workforce Experience

EXPLANATION: As part of the effort by Legal Affairs to review and update all policies and procedures over a five year period of time, Academic and Student Affairs reviewed BP 4-50. In partnership with the Student Life Development Council, this policy was updated to clearly state that “the student government’s membership shall represent and advocate for the diverse voices of the student body for which they are elected to serve.” Furthermore, the policy was revised to state that each college shall designate a full-time employee to serve as advisor to student government. All other changes were non-substantive and/or editorial.

The attached BP 4-50 reflects the non-substantive, editorial, or conforming changes to the policy. A redline version showing the details of all revisions is available upon request.

RECOMMENDATION: CCCS Staff recommends the Board approve the revisions to Board Policy BP 4-50.
