ACC NAMED BattChallenge YEAR ONE CHAMPION

The ACC and Colorado School of Mines team has been named as the Battery Workforce Challenge (BattChallenge) Year One champion. The three-year collegiate competition, which launched in the fall of 2023 and will continue through the spring of 2026, charges 12 university / technical school teams to design, build, test and integrate an advanced electric vehicle battery pack into a Stellantis vehicle. The program is an immersive hands-on learning experience for students to gain critical battery design and integration experience while developing engineering and technical skills beyond traditional engineering curriculum. Teams, which are collaborating to examine complex battery engineering and solve manufacturing challenges, were judged on the design of their electric vehicle battery pack in Year One. The teams' focus spanned from the granular level of cell characterization and testing to the broader scope of pack-level design, encompassing thermal, mechanical, and electrical considerations, while upholding stringent safety standards. BattChallenge seeks to build a highly skilled domestic workforce with the hands-on experience and knowledge needed for in-demand positions throughout the electric vehicle / battery industry.
