PURPOSE OF POLICY

To authorize the establishment and publication of a student life policy

LOCAL LANGUAGE

In accordance with Florida Statutes and State Board Rules, a policy shall be established by the Board of Trustees and published in the College Catalog.

The <u>NWF-Northwest Florida</u> State College <u>Student Development and</u> Campus Engagement Department follows Florida Statutes <u>§ FS-1006.5166</u>, and State Board Rules <u>SBR-6A-14.058</u> and <u>SBR-6A-14.057</u>. The <u>Executive</u> Director has the responsibility to ensure all student activities, events, clubs, organizations, Student Government Association (SGA), and intramurals have proper operations, designated student representatives, constitutions, and group advisors. <u>Further, the funds and expenditures will be</u> <u>submitted in a yearly budget, disbursed, received, and custodial accounting into College's fund.</u>

The Campus Engagement Department includes the Student Ombudsman Office for which the procedures are published in the College's Catalog on a yearly basis. The Student Development and Campus Engagement Department will represent the authority for the Student Ombudsman Office as stated in Florida Statute <u>FS 1006.51</u> for informally resolving student issues. The procedures are published in the College's Catalog on a yearly basis.

Under the accreditation standards applicable to the College, the President has ultimate responsibility for and exercises appropriate control over the College's intercollegiate athletics program. After the President, lintercollegiate <u>a</u>Athletics are the responsibility of the Athletic Director and are conducted according to State Board Rule <u>SBR 6A-19.004</u> for currently enrolled students. All activities are <u>conducted</u> inclusive of gender equity, scholarships, coaching, equipment, supplies, scheduling of games and practice times, promotion, support services, and recruitment of student athletes are in accordance to with Florida College System Activities Association and the National Junior College Athletic Association regulations.
