On December 14, 2021, the Princeton Police Department received the attached letter of resignation from Detective Alex Dehn. Detective Dehn has accepted a position as a Deputy with the Sherburne County Sheriffs Office. Detective Dehn's last day with the Department will be December 31, 2021.

Detective Dehn has been with the Princeton Police Department for 14 years and was a valuable officer in the department with special assignments as weapons instructor, Drug Task Force, Reserve Officer Supervisor and the Towards Zero Death Coordinator for the Department. Detective Dehn will be missed by the officers and Administration.

Staff requests that the City Council accept the resignation of Detective Dehn and authorize filling Detective Dehn's position immediately; selecting candidates from the applicant pool which closed on December 20, 2021.
