### RESOLUTION 20-15

#### A RESOLUTION FOR THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL FOR ACCEPTANCE OF THE CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUNDS

**WHEREAS**, on January 30, 2020, the International Health Regulations Emergency Committee of the World Health Organization declared the outbreak of the coronavirus disease of 2019 (COVID-19) a public health emergency of international concern; and,

**WHEREAS**, on March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization characterized COVID-19 as a pandemic; and,

**WHEREAS**, on March 13, 2020, the President of the United States declared the COVID-19 outbreak a national emergency; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Saint Paul Island, Alaska is preparing for threats to life, illnesses, critical supply shortages (food, water, fuel, medicine), critical workforce shortages, increased healthcare demands, increased water/sanitation service demands, and sustained economic losses requiring emergency protective measures to be taken; and,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Council of the City of Saint Paul accepts the Coronavirus Relief Funds in the amount of \$ 1,300,268.85, and wishes to provide the funds for the community of Saint Paul; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City of Saint Paul will use the funds for the costs that are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), from the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development.
