The System has reviewed this policy as part of its five-year review cycle. The revisions remove references to statutes and guidelines no longer applicable, and formulates a high-level compliance policy that will promulgate to the Chancellor, the authority to establish procedures for a private business grievance process, college and system guidelines, and any legal requirements as necessary.
