2022/23 Saint Matthew Island Section Blue King Crab Season Closed

The Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADF&G) and National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) have completed analysis of 2022 NMFS trawl survey results for Saint Matthew Island Section blue king crab. The stock is estimated below the federal minimum stock size threshold and, consequently, has been declared overfished. In addition, estimates for 2022 mature male abundance remain below the state harvest strategy threshold for a fishery opening. Therefore, Saint Matthew Island Section blue king crab will remain closed for the 2022/23 season.
