Suicide Prevention Team members

The Director of Student Services leads the Suicide Prevention Team for DCP. Additional members of the Suicide Prevention Team include DCP employees:

- 1. The school based Social worker/counselor from each site.
- 2. The Educational Related Mental Health Service (ERMHS) counselor.
- 3. The principal or designed administrator from each site.
- 4. Student and parent representatives as available.



Suicide Prevention Team

The functions of the SPCT are to:

- 1. Review mental health related school policies and procedures;
- 2. Provide annual updates on school data and trends;
- 3. Review and revise school prevention policies;
- 4. Review and select general and specialized mental health and suicide prevention training;
- 5. Review and oversee staff, parent/guardian, and student trainings;
- 6. Ensuring the suicide prevention policy, protocols, and resources are posted on the school website;
- 7. Identify resources and agencies that provide evidence-based or evidence-informed treatment;
- 8. Help inform and build skills among law enforcement and other relevant partners; and
- 9. Collaborate to build community response.



Awareness of Resources

- 1. Charter School shall establish and widely disseminate a referral process to all parents/guardians/caregivers/families, so they are aware of how to respond to a crisis and are knowledgeable about protocols and school, community-based, and crisis resources.
- 2. Community-based organizations that provide evidence-based suicide-specific treatments shall be highlighted on the Charter School's website with treatment referral options marked accordingly.
- 3. Staff autoreplies during vacations or absences shall include links to resources and phone/text numbers so parents and students have information readily available.



Our protocols and training

- 1. All staff trained every year through require modules.
- 2. Counseling team trained through specialized training.
- 3. Admin team trained in Spring 2024 to respond to a suicidal crisis or death by suicide.
- 4. September is Suicide Prevention month; The Wellness Team has facilitated activities at each site.
