

# **MEMORANDUM**

### **Annual Tuition Review**

Board Policy R510.5 requires the Board of Higher Education to annually review price-competitive tuition data including: comparisons with national and regional tuition and fee data, institutional cost data, median income statistics, average student debt load data, general and course fee data, and other affordability factors the Board identifies to determine if tuition adjustments are necessary to maintain fairness and price competitiveness. To facilitate that review, the Commissioner's office has developed the attached annual tuition summary document. This document provides summary data for degree-granting institutions across multiple variables covered in R510.5 and is provided to the Board for review.
