SUBJECT: Election – polling place

DATE: March 10, 2022

Now that the state redistricting plan has been adopted, all municipalities (and counties with unorganized territory) may proceed with reestablishing their precinct boundaries and designating their polling places by March 29 as required under M.S. 204B.14, subd. 3(e).

If there are precinct changes, the <u>Precinct Boundary Change Notice</u> should be used by cities, townships, or counties to notify this office of changes to precinct boundaries or names. Municipalities should also communicate these changes, as well as any polling place changes, to their county.

Cities with wards must also either confirm that their existing boundaries meet standards or redefine their ward boundaries by March 29. Changes to city wards should be reported to OSS along with the changes to precincts on the Precinct Boundary Change Notice.
