

**RESOLUTION #22-13**  
**Resolution Reestablishing Precincts and Polling Places**

\*\*\*\*\*

**WHEREAS**, the legislature of the State of Minnesota has been redistricted; and

**WHEREAS**, Minnesota Statute section 204B.14, subd. 3 (d) requires that precinct boundaries must be reestablished within 60 days of when the legislature has been redistricted or at least 19 weeks before the state primary election, whichever comes first;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Princeton, Counties of Mille Lacs and Sherburne State of Minnesota hereby reestablishes the boundaries of the voting precincts and polling places as follows:

Precinct 1 (The Depot, 101 10<sup>th</sup> Ave South)  
That part of the city within Mille Lacs County

Precinct 2 (The Depot, 101 10<sup>th</sup> Ave South)  
That part of the city within Sherburne County

Attached to this resolution, for illustrative purposes, is a map showing said precincts and the location of the polling place.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Princeton City Council that all City residents who reside in Mille Lacs County and Sherburne County will vote at the Depot, located at 101 10<sup>th</sup> Ave South, Princeton.
